RANGE RULES

ALWAYS treat every gun as if it were loaded

ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction

ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to fire

ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use

- 1 NO ONE is allowed past the firing line except staff.
- 2 NO ONE is allowed on the range under the influence of alcohol or other controlled substances.
- 3 EYE AND EAR PROTECTION must be worn at all times on the range.
- 4 NO FOOD OR DRINKS allowed in the range area.
- 5 Three shooters are allowed per lane.
- 6 All ammunition is subject to approval by the staff.
- 7 Drawing from a holster is not permitted unless specifically approved.
- 8 Firearms must be unloaded and actions open going to and leaving the firing line (except holstered handguns carried by CCW licensees or open carry).
- 9 All long guns must be inspected by staff before going to the range.
- 10 No high powered rifles allowed (at or over 2000 fps or 2000 ft-lbs).
- 11 No steel shot allowed.
- 12 If a misfire or other malfunction occurs, leave the firearm at the firing line pointed down range and obtain assistance from a staff member.

 DO NOT leave the firing line with a loaded or jammed firearm.

Any violation of range rules shall result in immediate reprimand and possible DISMISSAL from the range. There will be no refunds of any kind for persons expelled from the range for rule violations.
